*Jesus told the synagogue ruler [Jairus],
"Don't be afraid; just believe." Mark 5:36*

- A. Jairus **sought** Jesus
"Then one of the synagogue leaders, named Jairus, came, and when he saw Jesus, he fell at his feet" Mark 5:22
1. He came to Jesus **publicly** – he was not ashamed.
 2. He came to Jesus **himself** – he did not send someone.
- B. Jairus **invited** Jesus into his home.
"He pleaded earnestly with him, "My little daughter is dying. Please come and put your hands on her so that she will be healed and live." Mark 5:23
1. He **brought** Jesus into his home.
 2. He **allowed** Jesus to lead in his home.
- C. Jairus **committed** the welfare of his child to Jesus
"He took the child's father and mother and the disciples who were with Him, and went in where the child was. He took her by the hand and said to her, 'Talitha kum!' (which means, 'Little girl, I say to you, get up!'). Immediately, the girl stood up and began to walk around (she was twelve years old). At this they were completely astonished". Mark 5:40-42
1. He put his **daughter** into Jesus' hands.
 2. He **trusted** that the best plan for his daughter was God's plan.
