



**"Jesus Revealed
– A Study Through Revelation"
Three Key Figures... Chapters 11-13
"The Witnesses, The Woman, and The Beast"
"They overcame him by the blood of the Lamb and by
the word of their testimony;" Revelation 12:11a**

Introduction: Signs of the End of the Age are given in Matthew 24, Mark 13, and Luke 21. All three of these gospels give us pictures of things to come and certainly things that have not happened. At this point in Revelation, the Book of Daniel begins to come into play, as well.

A. The two witnesses (Chapter 11)...

1. Their testimony... We overcome by the blood of the Lamb!
2. Their time... 3 1/2 years!
3. Their power... blood and plagues.
4. Their identity... Moses and Elijah.
5. Their deaths... "Come up here!"

B. The woman (Chapter 12)...

1. The description... with twelve stars.
2. The symbol... the church.
3. The child... the Messiah.
4. The dragon... Satan.
5. The dragon's power... 7 horns with 7 crowns.

C. The beast (Chapter 13)...

1. The beast... the antichrist.
2. His symbols of 10 horns and 7 heads... complete power and authority.
3. His time... 3 1/2 years.
4. His power... over all who are not written in the Book of Life.
5. The second beast... the false prophet.
6. His symbols of 2 horns like a lamb... all his power is on behalf of the first beast.
7. The first beast survives a fatal head wound... he assumes full power over the earth.
8. He forces everyone to take the mark... 666!

D. Judgment on earth, but worship in heaven ...

1. Jesus is Victor!
"The kingdom of the world has become the kingdom of our Lord and of his Christ, and he will reign for ever and ever."
2. Jesus is Victor of past, present, and future!
"We give thanks to you, Lord God Almighty, the One who is and who was, because you have great power and have begun to reign."
3. Jesus is Victor and rewarding his saints!
"The time has come for judging the dead, and rewarding your servants the prophets and your saints and those who reverence your name, both small and great- and for destroying those who destroy the earth."
4. Jesus is Victor over sin and all the earth.
"Now have come the salvation and the power and the kingdom of our God, and the authority of his Christ."

5. Jesus is Victor over evil!
"For the accuser of our brothers, who accuse them before our God day and night, has been hurled down."
6. Jesus is Victor over the heavens and all who dwell in them!
"Therefore rejoice you heavens and you who dwell in them."
7. Jesus is Victor by the blood of the Lamb!!
"They overcame him by the blood of the Lamb and by the word of their testimony."
