



**"Jesus Revealed – A Study Through Revelation"**  
**Coming to the End and a Mighty**  
**Cheer... Chapters 17-19a**  
**"The Woman on the Beast,**  
**The Fall of Babylon, and A Supper!"**  
*"Hallelujah! Salvation and glory and power belong to our God for true and just are his judgments." Revelation 19:1b-2a*

**A. Justice is still being served...**

*"One of the seven angels who had the seven bowls came and said to me, 'Come, I will show you the punishment of the great prostitute, who sits on many waters.'"*

1. Another woman is presented representing Rome. She is the city on seven hills.
2. She is called the great prostitute with her name on her forehead.
3. There are seven heads and ten horns representing countries and power who are a part of leadership.
4. But...The Lamb is Jesus!

**B. Babylon is falling...**

*"After this I saw another angel coming down from heaven. He had great authority and the earth was illuminated by his splendor."*

1. There is a religious Babylon with one world religion and one religious leader...the false prophet!
2. There is a political Babylon with one world government and one world leader...the antichrist!
3. Both Babylons will fall and be destroyed.

4. The kings, the merchants, and the sea captains will all mourn this destruction in one day, in one hour and will watch in horror with great mourning!

**C. The hollow, empty sound of defeat was in the air...**

*"Then a mighty angel picked up a boulder the size of a large millstone and threw it into the sea and said: 'With such violence the great city of Babylon will be thrown down, never to be found again.'"*

1. Music was never to be heard again.
2. All work would be ended.
3. All the lights will be gone!
4. Never again will the voice of Christ be heard!

**D. The great "Hallelujah!" meaning praise the Lord...**

*"After this I heard what sounded like the roar of a great multitude in heaven shouting:"*

1. The first Hallelujah (or praise the Lord)! was to rejoice that judgment had come!

*"Hallelujah! Salvation and glory and power belong to our God, for true and just are his judgments."*

2. The second Hallelujah (or praise the Lord)! was to rejoice that the enemy to Christianity was destroyed.

*"And again they shouted: 'Hallelujah! The smoke from her goes up for ever and ever.' The twenty-four elders and the four living creatures fell down and worshiped God who was seated on the throne."*

3. The third Hallelujah (or praise the Lord)! was to rejoice that all Christians could give thanks together!

*"Amen, Hallelujah!" Then a voice came from the throne saying: 'Praise our God, all you his servants, you who fear him, both small and great!'"*

4. The Hallelujah (or praise the Lord)! was to rejoice that everyone could worship the King of Kings!

*"Then I heard what sounded like a great multitude, like the roar of rushing waters and like loud peals of thunder, shouting:*

*"Hallelujah! For our Lord God Almighty reigns. Let us rejoice and be glad and give him glory!"*

**E. The greatest wedding ever...**

*"For the wedding of the Lamb has come and his bride has made herself ready."*

1. The bridegroom is Jesus!

*"Jesus replied, 'Do wedding guests fast while celebrating with the groom? Of course not. They can't fast while the groom is with them.'" Mark 2:19*

2. The bride is the church!

*"For I am jealous for you with the jealousy of God himself. I promised you as a pure bride to one husband—Christ."*

2 Corinthians 11:2

*"For husbands, this means love your wives, just as Christ loved the church. He gave up his life for her to make her holy and clean, washed by the cleansing of God's word. He did this to present her to himself as a glorious church without a spot or wrinkle or any other blemish. Instead, she will be holy and without fault."*

Ephesians 5:25-27

3. The marriage supper is the great celebration of the return of Christ!

*"Blessed are those who are invited to the wedding supper of the Lamb"*

4. This invitation is extended to the called, the chosen, and the faithful followers whose names are in the Book of Life!

*"The blood of the Lamb will overcome them because he is Lord of Lords and King of Kings— and with him will be his called, chosen, and faithful followers."*

Called: *"In his kindness God called you to share in his eternal glory by means of Christ Jesus."* 1 Peter 5:10a

Chosen: *"You didn't choose me. I chose you."* John 15:16a

Faithful followers: *"You are my friends if you do what I command."* John 15:14
