



**"Jesus Revealed – A Study through Revelation"  
The Victor's Return and  
The Thousand Years...Chapter 19a-20  
"The King of Kings and Lord of Lords"  
"I saw heaven standing open and there before me was a white  
horse, whose rider is called Faithful and True."  
Revelation 19:11a**

**A. The Victor's return...**

*"I saw heaven standing open and there before me was a white horse, whose rider is called Faithful and True."*

1. The Conqueror returns on a white horse.
2. He is called Faithful and True. Faithful meaning He can be absolutely trusted. True meaning that He brings truth in all He says, and true meaning He is genuine.
3. When He comes, He will exercise His power with justice.
4. His eyes are like blazing fire showing the consuming power of the victorious Christ.
5. He wears multiple crowns showing his power over the kingdoms of this earth.

*"Therefore, God elevated him to the place of highest honor and gave him the name above all other names, that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth, and every tongue declare that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father." Philippians 2:9-11*

6. His robe is dipped in the blood of His enemies.

7. His powerful sword is His word.

*"For the word of God is alive and powerful. It is sharper than the sharpest two-edged sword, cutting between soul and spirit, between joint and marrow. It exposes our innermost thoughts and desires."*

Hebrews 4:12

8. The armies of heaven or his angels will accompany Him.
9. He comes with the wrath of God over sin.
10. He comes... "King of Kings and Lord of Lords."

**B. The enemies' destruction...**

*"And the demonic spirits gathered all the rulers and their armies to a place with the Hebrew name Armageddon." Revelation 16:16*

1. The destruction of the kings, generals, and mighty men of war will be seen by all, often called the Battle of Armageddon.
2. The beast and the false prophet will be captured and thrown into the fiery lake of burning sulfur.
3. The rest of the armies will be killed.
4. An angel will seize Satan and bind him. He will throw him into the Abyss for a thousand years.

**C. The Thousand years...**

*"...They will be priests of God and of Christ and will reign with him for a thousand years."*

1. There are three positions in regard to the thousand years: Premillennial, Postmillennial, and Amillennial.
2. Christ will reign on earth for a thousand years.
3. The martyrs will be brought to life and reign with Christ during this time. This is the first resurrection.
4. The second death has no power over them. "Born once, die twice. Born twice, die once!" –Martin Luther
5. Satan will be released at the close of the thousand years.
6. Satan will be thrown into the lake of burning sulfur where the beast and the false prophet are tormented day and night for ever and ever.

**D. The Judgment...**

1. The Great White Throne Judgment comes for all.  
*"For we must all stand before Christ to be judged. We will each receive whatever we deserve for the good or evil we have done in this earthly body." 2 Corinthians 5:10*

*"Remember, we will all stand before the judgment seat of God."*  
Romans 14:10

2. Heaven and earth pass away as we know it.  
*"...Then the heavens will pass away with a terrible noise, and the very elements themselves will disappear in fire, and the earth and everything on it will be found to deserve judgment." 2 Peter 3:10b*

3. There are two books to be opened: The Book of Deeds and The Book of Life.

*"For the Son of Man will come with his angels in the glory of his Father and will judge all people according to their deeds." Matthew 16:27*

*"He will judge everyone according to what they have done."*  
Romans 2:6

*"...They worked along with Clement and the rest of my co-workers, whose names are written in the Book of Life."*  
Philippians 4:3b

*"All who are victorious will be clothed in white. I will never erase their names from the Book of Life, but I will announce before my Father and his angels that they are mine." Revelation 3:5*

4. At the resurrection, all who have ever lived will be resurrected and stand before the Great White Throne Judgment.

*"And just as each person is destined to die once and after that comes judgment," Hebrews 9:27*

5. The lake of fire is the second death for all who are not found in the Book of Life.

*"If anyone's name was not found written in the book of life, he was thrown into the lake of fire."*

**E. There is coming a time of Victory...**

1. We know the end of the story...and Jesus wins!
2. We know His victory will be complete!
3. We know that this victor can be trusted...absolutely!
4. We know this victor brings genuine truth and His Word can be trusted, too!
5. So...trust him...today!
