*“I will raise up for them a prophet like you from among their brothers. And I will put My words in his mouth, and he shall speak to them all that I command him.”*

*Deuteronomy 18:18 ESV*

**A. Moses was a shadow of Jesus...**

*“The old system under the law of Moses was only a shadow, a dim preview of the good things to come, not the good things themselves. The sacrifices under that system were repeated again and again, year after year, but they were never able to provide perfect cleansing for those who came to worship.” Hebrews 10:1*

1. Both Moses and Jesus were saved in Egypt from a tyrannical leader.
2. Both Moses and Jesus survived testing after passing through water.
3. Jesus’ five major sermons mirrored the Torah, the first five books of the Old Testament.
4. Both Moses and Jesus had a conversation on top of a mountain during the transfiguration.
5. Jesus’ Last Supper was during the Passover meal that Moses established!
6. Both were liberators, lawgivers, and shepherds.

**B. Moses brought redemption to his people...**

*“Therefore, say to the people of Israel: ‘I am the LORD. I will free you from your oppression and will rescue you from your slavery in Egypt. I will redeem you with a powerful arm and great acts of judgment.’” Exodus 6:6*

1. God called Moses at the burning bush to be the savior of His people.

*“There the angel of the LORD appeared to him in a blazing fire from the middle of a bush. Moses stared in amazement. Though the bush was engulfed in flames, it didn’t burn up.” Exodus 3:2-3*

2. After the plagues in Egypt, Moses instituted the Passover, a symbol of redemption.

*“But the blood on your doorposts will serve as a sign, marking the houses where you are staying. When I see the blood, I will pass over you. This plague of death will not touch you when I strike the land of Egypt.” Exodus 12:13*

3. Moses led the people out of Egypt through the Red Sea.

*“Then Moses raised his hand over the sea, and the LORD opened up a path through the water with a strong east wind. The wind blew all that night, turning the seabed into dry land.” Exodus 14:21*

4. Moses received instructions for the tabernacle, all that was entailed in worship, and the Ten Commandments.

*“Moses remained there on the mountain with the LORD forty days and forty nights. In all that time he ate no bread and drank no water. And the LORD wrote the terms of the covenant—the Ten Commandments—on the stone tablets.” Exodus 34:28*

5. Moses led his people through the wilderness to the Promised Land.

*“But I have promised you, ‘You will possess their land because I will give it to you as your possession—a land flowing with milk and honey.’ I am the LORD your God, who has set you apart from all other people.” Leviticus 20:24*

**C. God’s love came through Jesus...**

*“For the law was given through Moses, but God’s unfailing love and faithfulness came through Jesus Christ.” John 1:17*

1. Jesus was the one the prophets predicted.

*“Philip went to look for Nathanael and told him, ‘We have found the very person Moses and the prophets wrote about! His name is Jesus, the son of Joseph from Nazareth.’” John 1:45*

2. Just as Moses lifted up a pole, so Jesus would be lifted up on the cross.

*“And as Moses lifted up the bronze snake on a pole in the wilderness, so the Son of Man must be lifted up, so that everyone who believes in Him will have eternal life.” John 3:14-15*

3. Jesus came to be the Bread of life.

*“Jesus said, ‘I tell you the truth, Moses didn’t give you bread from heaven. My Father did. And now He offers you the true bread from heaven.’” John 6:32*

4. Just as Moses had the veil covering his face, their hearts were veiled, and they did not understand. But Jesus took the veil away!

*“Yes, even today when they read Moses’ writings, their hearts are covered with that veil, and they do not understand. But whenever someone turns to the Lord, the veil is taken away. For the Lord is the*

*Spirit, and wherever the Spirit of the Lord is, there is freedom. So all of us who have had that veil removed can see and reflect the glory of the Lord. And the Lord—who is the Spirit—makes us more and more like Him as we are changed into His glorious image.”*

*2 Corinthians 3:15-18*

**D. Jesus fulfilled all that Moses brought to the people...**

*“‘The day is coming,’ says the LORD, ‘when I will make a new covenant with the people of Israel and Judah. This covenant will not be like the one I made with their ancestors when I took them by the hand and brought them out of the land of Egypt. They broke that covenant, though I loved them as a husband loves his wife,’ says the LORD. ‘But this is the new covenant I will make with the people of Israel after those days,’ says the LORD. ‘I will put My instructions deep within them, and I will write them on their hearts. I will be their God, and they will be My people.’” Jeremiah 31:31-33*

1. Jesus wants to be Bread of life to us! Are you willing to let Jesus be the most essential part of your life and the gift of eternal life?

*“Jesus replied, ‘I am the bread of life. Whoever comes to Me will never be hungry again. Whoever believes in Me will never be thirsty.’” John 6:35*

2. Jesus wants to be our deliverer. He will rescue you! Are you willing to trust Him for deliverance in your life?

*“And He did rescue us from mortal danger, and He will rescue us again. We have placed our confidence in Him, and He will continue to rescue us.” 2 Corinthians 1:10*

3. Jesus wants you to see clearly the truth of life. Are you willing to believe that Christ can give you the truth and not the world’s sources?

*“But the people’s minds were hardened, and to this day whenever the old covenant is being read, the same veil covers their minds so they cannot understand the truth. And this veil can be removed only by believing in Christ.” 2 Corinthians 3:14*

4. The Holy Spirit will now be your guide. Will you surrender to His guidance and not your own?

*“When the Spirit of truth comes, He will guide you into all truth. He will not speak on His own but will tell you what He has heard. He will tell you about the future.” John 16:13*

5. Jesus wants to be your Savior! Are you willing to trust Him with your life?

*“There is salvation in no one else! God has given no other name under heaven by which we must be saved.” Acts 4:12*
